- 4) Absolutely no alcohol or smoking is permitted. Cigarette lighters and matches are strictly forbidden.
- 5) Any student with allergies, dietary requirements and medication must tick the required box on the attached permission slip, with any additional information needed, and any medicines must be handed into staff at the centre.
- 6) Students will be expected to behave in an orderly and courteous fashion, both on the bus to and from the centre, in the centre itself and on all activities.

Failure to comply with the above rules will result in parents being contacted and asked to collect their son / daughter from the centre.
