Note: 2023/2024 School Expenses are per student and are as follows: 1st Year €250 * 2nd Year €255 * 3rd Year €285 * 4th Year €50 * 5th Year & LCA1 €250 * 6th Year & LCA2 €285. Voluntary Contribution €50 per family. School Expenses and the Voluntary Contribution are payable through the School App only.

School Expenses can be paid in two ways: A) in one lump sum by selecting 'PAY IN FULL – ADD TO CART' in your shop on the App, or B) by instalments selecting 'PAY BY INSTALMENTS – PAY IN INSTALMENT' in your shop. We would also very much appreciate payment of the Family Voluntary Contribution of €50.

We request that School Expenses are paid in full by May 2024; if paying by instalments we ask that you process your first instalment at your earliest convenience. The remaining instalments will then be taken each month automatically.

Please note cash is not accepted by Karen in the school office. Thank you.

All Students Must Have:

- 1) With the increase in student project work at both Junior and Senior Cycle it is necessary for students to have their own access to black and white/colour printers. The school does not have the capacity to print personal projects for students due to the volume and cost.
- 2) It is advisable to have access to a computer/laptop for their schoolwork, i.e. practical project work, etc.
- 3) The official School Journal, the cost of which is incorporated in 2023/2024 School Expenses, is supplied by the school. During the year if the School Journal is lost or becomes unfit for use, a replacement Journal must be bought at a cost of €20.
